Getting to Know You...

In the months and years ahead, you'll hear a lot more from me. I plan to stay here at Community until I retire, which is still a long way away! In that time, we will work together, walk together, love and serve together, showing others a path toward deeper life in Jesus. You have so far done such a great job of making me feel welcome, so I know you're good at hospitality! Together we need to spread our hospitality to people in every step of life's walk, in every moment of doubt and questioning, as well as every deep moment of faithful joy.
